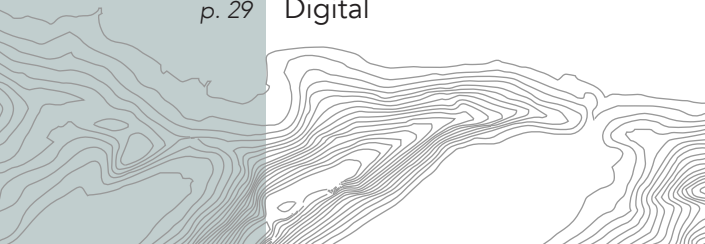

AREAS WHERE YOU CAN SERVE

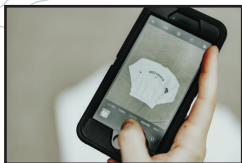
COMMUNITY GROUP LEADER

MERCH

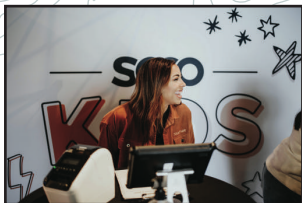
We sell merch at SOCO because we believe that you can LOOK good and DO good at the same time. All proceeds from merch sales go directly to our local, national, and global missions.

PRODUCTION

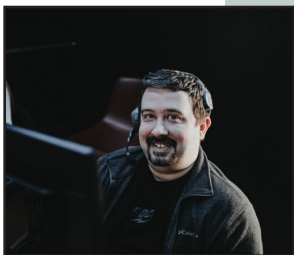


The production team at SOCO Church helps create an immersive, powerful, and distraction free environment
