PRODUCTION

ASSISTANT PRODUCER

The Assistant Producer supports the Service Producer by managing details like Stage cues, mic transitions, and ensuring smooth execution of all elements. They also help coordinate volunteer teams and provide backup assistance wherever needed.

AUDIO ENGINEER

The Audio Engineer is responsible for mixing live audio to create a clear, balanced sound for both the room and online broadcast. They work closely with the worship team to adjust microphone levels, in-ear monitors, and troubleshoot any sound issues.

CAMERA OPERATOR

The Camera Operator captures high-quality, well-framed shots that enhance the storytelling and worship experience. They follow the video director's instructions to switch angles, adjust movements, and keep visuals engaging for both in-person and online audiences.

LIGHTING ENGINEER

The Lighting Engineer operates lighting cues that enhance the worship atmosphere and align with the service flow. They ensure proper lighting levels for both in-person and broadcast audiences, adjusting as needed for clarity and impact.

PRO PRESETER OPERATOR

The ProPresenter Operator manages and advances all on-screen content, including lyrics, sermon slides, and media elements. They ensure smooth transitions and troubleshoot technical issues to maintain a distraction-free worship experience.

SERVICE PRODUCER

The Service Producer oversees the entire production flow, ensuring a seamless and distraction-free worship experience. They communicate with all production team members, calling cues and managing transitions.

VIDEO DIRECTOR

The Video Director leads live camera feeds, graphics, and prerecorded elements to create a dynamic and professional broadcast. They work closely with the camera operators and ProPresenter team to ensure seamless visual transitions throughout the service.

PROJECTS

The Projects Team handles requests that come in to better the premises and/or prepare for upcoming events. These are typically one-off projects, requiring something to be repaired or maintained, something new to be built for an upcoming event, or setting up/tearing down for major events. This team plays a critical role in providing the visitor with a unique, well planned out experience.

PYV (PLAN YOUR VISIT)

Serving on the PYV Team means being the first friendly face someone sees at SOCO. You help guests feel seen, valued, and at home from the moment they arrive, turning what could be an intimidating visit into a warm, welcoming experience. This could include answering any questions, helping families check their children into SOCO Kids, or giving tours of the building.

Your role isn't just helpful, it's crucial in making first impressions that last.

SECURITY

The Security and Medical Response Team is responsible for ensuring the safety and security of the premises, responding promptly to any security/Medical threats or emergencies. The team is trained to handle a range of security-related issues, including surveillance, access control, and emergency evacuation procedures. Additionally, they are equipped with the skills and resources to provide immediate medical assistance during emergencies, including administering first aid, CPR, and coordinating with external medical services for more serious incidents.

SHUTTLE

The Shuttle Team is responsible for transporting volunteers and attendees safely and efficiently between the parking lots and our main building. The drivers are the first contact that day with our church experience, and as such, we hope to provide them a warm welcome, bring a smile to their face, and assist passengers as needed. They play a key role in ensuring that individuals can easily access the premises while maintaining a high standard of service and safety throughout their shuttle experience.

SOCO KIDS

SOCO Kids is more than childcare. It's a ministry where the foundation of faith is being laid in the hearts of the next generation. Every Sunday, we serve children from 6 weeks through 5th grade with age-specific classrooms, engaging curriculum, and intentional care.
